2011 SHOWTIME INFORMATION



“Footwork Follies ~ 2011” will be presented in **FOUR** performances:

- Thursday, June 16th – 7p.m./curtain
- Friday, June 17th - 7p.m./curtain
- Saturday, June 18th – 3:00p.m. - Matinee/curtain
- Saturday, June 18th – 6:30p.m./curtain



- Each performance will be staged at the **Biester Theater, at Glenbard East High School, 1014 South Main Street, just six blocks NORTH of Roosevelt Road in Lombard.** A map is attached to this packet.
- You are to use Door #20 (on the South end of the building) in bringing your student to the Cafeteria. *(However, if the South Parking lot is full, you are to use the NORTH PARKING lot and proceed to DOOR # 1, to the 2nd floor, turn right to get to the cafeteria and Biester Theater).*
- Students **MUST BE** in attendance at their **ASSIGNED** cafeteria table at least **20 MINUTES BEFORE** curtain. There will be signs directing you to the cafeteria as you enter the building. Once you have brought your student to the Cafeteria, you may proceed to the Theater. Under no circumstances is a performing student allowed into the theater. Entrance into the theater may not be made without a ticket.

STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO HAVE CELLPHONES – due to privacy issues (the cafeteria is a changing area) and policy. If found, we will confiscate the phone and only return it to a parent/guardian AFTER the show.

- **Students are to remain in the cafeteria with their table supervisor during the entire performance** (approximately 60 minutes for the Matinee; 90-to 100 minutes for main performances). We sincerely thank all the parents who cooperate with us by following this simple request. We know you understand that in order for us to produce our fast-paced shows, it is **IMPERATIVE** the production crew be able to move students quickly, keep track of everyone, **and not be distracted by parents and special demands.** Again, the instructors, secretaries, room-mothers, and crewmembers, gratefully thank our conscientious parents for this courtesy.
- Students are to arrive in the cafeteria **DRESSED** in their **FIRST** routine's costume. **Please remember ALL dance shoes.** One family member can assist younger students' with costume changes. The performance lineups for all four shows will be posted at dress rehearsal. Students **MUST WEAR** full stage makeup for **PERFORMANCES** (*base, blush, powder, eyeshadow, mascara, deep-colored lipstick*). Mothers should apply makeup to younger students at home. Just keep in mind that you want your child's face to show up under bright lights. **BUT**, you *do not* want them to look like clowns for the camera. Light, healthy meals should be eaten **before performances.** A washroom break should be considered right **before** driving them to the theater. **EVERY CLASS** will be assigned a table in the cafeteria. Tables will be marked with their **ROUTINE #.** Students can bring games, coloring books and crayons. **NO MARKERS OR PENS.** We will be televising the performances into the cafeteria. **Due to a variety of food allergies -NO SNACKS, NO TREATS, NO FOOD/DRINKS ARE ALLOWED!!!**
- **Students ARE NOT ALLOWED in the THEATER BEFORE or DURING performances!** No student or parent is allowed to bring in any **LATEX** products (balloons, etc). Glenbard is a NO LATEX school.
- **VIDEO TAPING is NOT ALLOWED during the PERFORMANCES.** [You may make your *personal* video tape of your students class only during the dress rehearsals on Tuesday/Wednesday. *Anyone using a Video camera during any performance will be told to leave the theater by the house manager and ushers.*]
- **FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY is NOT ALLOWED during the performances.** [Please Note: At least 12 seats around the *Sound Memories* video equipment will have a blocked view of the stage.]
- The Theater Doors will open **45 minutes** before each performance for seating. Tickets **MUST** be purchased for **EVERY** seat used. This means that if you are holding an infant, a ticket is **NOT** necessary. Two years old and up requires a ticket. **There are NO REFUNDS on ticket purchases.**
- Family members can save seats as long as one person sits with them. **Saving of seats is limited to 8.** **ROPING AND TAPING OFF SEATS IS NOT ALLOWED.** *All ropes and tape will be removed by the ushers.*

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCE WILL ANYONE BE ADMITTED INTO THE AUDITORIUM WITHOUT A TICKET. MAKE SURE YOUR TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE TO BE PRESENTED AT THE DOOR! If you forget your purchased tickets at home, you will need to buy additional tickets and there is NO REFUND on your originally purchased tickets!
